



NEW STUDENTS INFORMATION SHEET ON IT SERVICES

Welcome to EdUHK! There are many online services available for our students, including course registration, personal time-table, library catalogue, e-learning, hostel application, locker application, email (Google Gmail), and etc. Students can access most of the services on any PC that is connected to the Internet with their accounts and passwords without much training. The Office of the Chief Information Officer (OCIO) is responsible for the support of IT at the University. The information provided below would enable you to start enjoying the IT services as soon as possible. Feel free to contact us if you have any problems.

COMPUTING ACCOUNTS

All students are provided with computer accounts for accessing the EdUHK online/network services, Google Gmail and Office 365 services. Please refer to the following principle on how your account username and password are set.

Username	's' + first 7 digits of your EdUHK student number e.g. If the student number is <u>1012345</u> 6, username will be s1012345.
Initial Password	First 6 digits of your EdUHK student number + last 4 digits of your HKID number (including the check digit) or last 4 digits of Mainland ID number (內地身分証號碼) (for Mainland students) / passport number (for overseas students) e.g. If the student number is 10123456: - HKID holders: if HKID number is Z987654(A), the initial password will be 101234654a; - Mainland students: if 內地身分証號碼 is 220890199008075678, the initial password will be 1012345678; - Overseas students: if passport number is ABC12345678, the initial password will be 1012345678.
Internet Email Address	'username'@s.eduhk.hk e.g. If the username is s1012345, internet email address will be s1012345@s.eduhk.hk.

Notes:

- 1. Computer accounts are created automatically for all students.
- 2. For security reasons, students are recommended to change the account passwords when they get the accounts. It is the University's policy that users should change their passwords every year. To change the passwords, please visit the University Portal (portal.eduhk.hk), click "Change password" and follow the instructions on screen.
- 3. For Google Gmail, Office 365 services and Wi-Fi service outside campus, please login with your Internet Email Address and use the same password.
- 4. All EdUHK computer accounts will be terminated when you cease to be a student of the University.

These include anti-virus software for home use, AV equipment/one-day notebook loan service to facilitate student learning, printing service, electronic form for data collection, and many more.
