Payment Methods

Students are **NOT** required to return the deposit slips, but please keep them as documentary proof of your payment for future reference. Please check with your Bill Payment service provider for the daily cut-off time of transactions and ensure that you have paid the outstanding fees before the cut-off time, at least, one working day before the due date.

Open your personal bank's mobile App. Scan the QR code shown in the pop-up window. Amend the amount to be paid if needed. Close the pop-up window after payment.</p>
5. Bank Deposit	<p>Payment by making deposit at any branch of the Bank of East Asia, Limited. Crossed cheque should be made payable to "The Education University of Hong Kong". Please provide Bill Type [02] Hostel & its related fees in addition to your 8-digit student number to the counter. The bank account number is "015-195-40-00511-5".</p>
