# Internship Programmes

We offer a variety of internship opportunities in collaboration with external partners across local, overseas, and the Greater China region. Our programmes include:

## Career Development Internship Programme (CDIP)

- ▶ Local Internship (Hong Kong)
  - Offers opportunities in non-governmental organisations (NGOs), social enterprises (SE) and corporate sectors
  - Enables students to gain valuable work experience and develop into local social leaders and future professionals
- ▶ Greater China Region Internship
  - Focuses the opportunities in entrepreneurship, innovation, and economic growth in mainland China and students can build professional networks in advance
- ▶ Overseas Internship
  - Allows students to gain diverse cultural and professional experiences and expands students' international perspective and adaptability
  - Provides experiences of the world from various perspectives while students apply academic knowledge in real-world settings across multiple fields

## Government Internship

- Enables students to understand the workings of government and public services

## STEM Internship

- Encourages students from STEM-related programmes to gain innovation and technology (I&T) work experience, fostering interests in the I&T sector by expanding the local talent pool
- Obtains a comprehensive understanding of the workplace culture and business environment



# Career Visits

Career visits are arranged in collaboration with external partners in Hong Kong, overseas, and the Greater China region. These visits provide students with first-hand information on diverse industries and work environments with networking opportunities.

## Career Fairs

- ▶ Hong Kong and Mainland Recruitment and Networking Expo
  - Focuses local and Mainland China internship and job opportunities for local and non-local students
- ▶ EdUHK Career Fair
  - Connects students with employers from all industries and regions, providing opportunities via guided tours, networking sessions, internships and employment



## Talks & Workshops

- ▶ Recruitment, careers and industry talks and workshops are available to equip students with essential skills and knowledge for future career development. Topics cover CV writing, interview techniques, industry insights and networking. Collaboration ideas from employers, alumni and industry experts are welcome, to enhance the learning experience by sharing with students the most relevant and up-to-date information.

## Networking Opportunities

- ▶ "Enlightening Professionals" Mentorship Scheme
  - A networking platform that creates an active and engaged community by bringing current students, EdUHK alumni and professionals together
- ▶ Alumni Net Scheme
  - Connects final year students with experienced and enthusiastic EdUHK alumni who offer career advice and help resolve job search challenges during the job-hunting journey

## Career Advising Services



- Provides personalised support to help students navigate their career paths. Through one-on-one sessions, students receive tailored guidance on resume writing, interview preparation and career planning



## Networking Opportunities



- **Ed Job Plus – EdUHK Complimentary Online Job Search & Information System**
  - Provides EdUHK students, graduates and employers a one-stop job search experience. It offers students career planning resources and practical advice for the job-hunting journey
- **Self-Assessment Tools and Resources**
  - Supports students' career planning journey. With the importance of self-assessment, students can uncover their strengths, interests, values, and skills. These reflective insights are crucial for identifying potential career paths and making informed career decisions



## Career Support for



- **Non-local Students**
  - Raises students' awareness of career opportunities, job requirements and employers' expectations for students to develop their careers in Hong Kong, the mainland and beyond
