### HOW TO ACCESS SEN SUPPORT SERVICES

- 1 Disclose your SEN to the Registry upon admission **OR** Contact the SEN Support Services of Student Affairs Office (SAO) whenever you are in need after admission
- 2 Submit the **SEN Record Form** and supporting documents 
- 3 Attend an intake session with SEN Case Coordinator
- 4 Meet the SEN Case Coordinator and Programme Representatives for the support services
