Types of Eligible Outreach Activities

The ROAs aim at equipping students with an international vision, broadening their exposure to multicultural environment and enhancing their communication skills in English, Putonghua or other languages. The outreach activity should be mainly course or placement related learning/internship/service programme OR national/regional/international event and competition. Major types of eligible outreach activities and related activities are summarised in the table below for internal reference.

Activity Type	Example of Related Activities
Event / Competition	Competitions / Conferences/ Forums/ Workshops/ Seminars/ Service-related Activities (e.g. Service Projects, Service Trips, Service Learning Programmes, etc.) / Training Camps
Internship / Placement	Credit-bearing/ Non-credit bearing Internship
Field/ Study Trip	Cultural Exploring Trip/ Programme-related Field Trip/ Research Project/Trip
Attending Course	Academic Exchange Programme/ Foreign Language Immersion Programme

More on Reaching Out Awards

- Institution should not charge the awardee any administrative fee for organising the learning, internship or service programme.
- The Reaching Out Awards are not on reimbursement basis but may cover whole/ part of the expenses incurred during the outreaching activities, such as tuition fees, airfare, accommodation and other incidental expenses.
- Students who have been awarded of ROA should not receive it again in the same programme of study.
- On completion of the outreaching programmes, each awardee is required to submit a reflection report on the activities participated and the learning experiences and benefits acquired to EdUHK within one month of returning to Hong Kong or official application result announcement. The Government reserves the right to publish the reports and photos (in full or in part) submitted by ROA recipients, either online or in print.
- The award money should be returned to the Government by the awardee who finally fails to participate in any of the proposed outreaching activities.
