

Professor Jim Chi-yung on harm to old trees done by poisonous moths

- *i-Cable* reported on the harm done by poisonous moths to five old trees in Park Lane Shoppers' Avenue in Tsim Sha Tsui. Professor Jim Chi-yung, Advisor and Adjunct Chair Professor (Geography & Environmental Science), explained that global warming has accelerated the growth of moths, pointing out that trees with too many leaves eaten by moths would lack photosynthesis and hence become more vulnerable to fungi and easily fall ill. The LCSD responded that poisonous moths so far have not caused serious damage to the five old trees.
