Why do we select this topic? (選取這個課題的原因)

 Many students are not able to give sufficient supporting details when describing a person's personalities.

 Many students are not able to express their ideas systematically in their writing.

Object of Learning (學習內容):

A method to enrich the description of a person's personality by elaborating on his/her habits and supported by past events.

Critical features (關鍵特徵):

- CF1: Habits and past events can be used to elaborate on a person's personality.
- CF2: Habits are expressed in present tense and past events in past tense.
- CF3: Personality can be revealed through a person's habits, and past events can be used as supporting evidence of such habits.
