Applicants should have a Bachelor's degree in Education, Educational Technology, Computer Science, Psychology, or a related discipline. They should be self-motivated, passionate about educational research, and have good interpersonal and coordination skills. Also, they should have a good command of both written and spoken English and Chinese (including Cantonese and Mandarin). Preference will be given to candidates who possess experience with learning analytics, data science, and AI techniques.
